In the House of Delegates/ Saturday the 21st June 1783

Resolved that the petition of George Draper praying that his pay & depreciation acc't may be settled in the same manner and upon the like proof as is prescribed in the case of Officers and Soldiers and that He may be allowed the same bounty in Land as is [undeciphered word] by Law to the Surgeons of [illegible word] Virginia line in Continental pay is reasonable
