Be pleased settle my pay & depreciation in the state Garrison Rgt. with my Land Warrant with Mr John Heath & oblige John hisXmark Dye Test/ Wm Miskell

Richmond May 25th 1784

I do certify That John Die a Soldier belonging to The State Garrison Regiment served the term of three years as a Soldier, in the s'd Rigiment from The 24th July 1779 untill 24th of July Eighty two at which time he was discharged D. Mann Lt [David Mann] Copy J. Pendleton
