Personally appeared Matthew Ellis who made Oath that he serv'd three years in Harrisons [Charles Harrison VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery as a private, that he receiv'd a discharge from Colo. Harrison at Hillsborough [North Carolina] which discharge he has lost.

Sworn to before me the 26th day of May 1780. Dan'l. Sanford

James Bray [VAS2623] also maketh Oath that he was present & saw the aforesaid Matt. Ellis receive his discharge. Sworn to before Dan'l Sanford Entitled to depreciation from Sep'r Seventy Seven to Sep'r Eighty If not setled Aug't 18th 86. Thos. Meriwether

Norfolk County

Matt. Ellis assignd all his right and title of the within to Capt. Thos Armistad [Thomas Armistead] May 26th 1780 in presence of Dan'l Sanford a Copy [undeciphered] Southall

Thomas Armistead Assignee of Matthew Ellis is entitled to the proportion of Land allowed a Private of the Continental Line for Three years Services T. Meriwether Council Chamber August 18th 1786
