Wake County

This day came before Us Jacob Hoofman and David Peck Who being Sworn on the Holy Evangalist Of Living God depose and say that they ware [undeciphered word] acquainted with John Embry Who was a Regular Soldier in the Service of the United States in the Revolutionary War, that he Enlisted in this State under the Command of Capt. Vanoise as they have understood And these deponents further say that [undeciphered] Embry is the Father of said John Embry who serv'd as above stated. Given under Our Hands and Seals this the 8th of September 1820
