This is to Certify that Charles Ficklin Inlisted himself Under me, as Soldier, the 14th Dec'r. 1776; to Serve in the 1[?]th Virginia Contntl Regiment, the Term of Three years; and that the Said Ficklin Dec'd. [deceased] in July 1777. Thomas Fox [R14268] Captn May 13th 1785

Sir Please Issue to Capt. Thos. Fox an Order to the Land Office for the bounty of Land allow'd Char's. Ficklin Dec'd a three years Soldier, which land by law, is my right who, is the Lawful Representative of the said Charles Ficklin & this shall be your warrent for so doing from

Test/ D Simpson To Colo. Thomas Meriweather [sic: Thomas Meriwether] Richmond Sir your Humb'l. Serv't. Thomas Ficklin May 13th 1785
