I do hereby Certifie that James Fitzgerald was enlisted in the first Virginia state Regiment [see endnote] the seventeenth of January one thousand seven hundred & seventy seven for the term of three years, & was discharged from the service by Col Mobeal [sic: Nicholas George Moëballé] the said Fitzgerald was one of my recruits as certified the Tenth of June one Thousand seven hundred & Eighty Three
