I certify that James Gray enlisted in the continental Service in September one thousand seven hundred and seventy seven to serve as a Corporal in the 7th Virg'a Reg't Reenlisted at West Point in October one thousand seven hundred and seventy eight for the War – at that time he was appointed Sergeant and continued in service till he got leave of absence
