George Fritts Late Drummer in Cap. Singleton [Anthony Singleton BLWt2068-300] comp'y of the first Reg't Artillery Comm'd by Colo Charles Harrison [VAS1411], having serv'd for which he stood engag'd is hereby Discharg'd from the service of United States. His conduct as a Soldier justly entitles him to the Respect & Esteem of all his Countrymen.

Given under my hand at the park of Artillery near Morristown this 10th day April 1780. Ed. Carrenton Lt Colo 4th V Reg't [sic: Edward Carrington W6635] A Singleton Capt
