Campbell County Aug. 28th 1831

To all who shall see this certificate. Know that we have been personally acquainted with William Fruit for a good many years and believe him to be an honest, upright, and unpretending man one who we do not believe would claim any thing that did not justly belong to him.

This day William P Hamlett [S13305] came before me a justice of the Peace for the county of Charlotte and made oath that William Fruit enlisted as a regular soldier in the Virginia State line & continued in service from the time he enlisted until the close of the revolutionary war in a company commanded by Captain Peter Randolph whose company belonged to a regiment commanded by Colonel Everett Meade [Everard Meade BLWt2063-300] given under my hand this 12th day of September 1831
