This day came Susanna Gahagan before me a Justice of the peace for said County and made oath according to law that she is the mother of John Gahagan who enlisted as a [undeciphered word] in the virginia line belonging to united States of america and the said John Gahagan Died in the Hospital in November 1778 and that William Gahagan his Brother is the Heir at Law to his Estate.

Sworn Before us the 3^d day of August 1784

William [undeciphered]/ James Steel

I do Certify that John Gahagin entered the service in July 1775 and continued in service till January 1777 when he [undeciphered word] into the Virginia Continental line for the War and Died in the fall 1778 Given under my hand this 3^d day of Sept 1784
