William Galley Soldier in Col. Posey's [Thomas Posey BLWt1733-450] Regiment of Continental Troops having served the term for which he was Engaged is hereby Discharged the Service Given at Cumberland old Court House Nov'r the 3rd 1782

I do hereby Certify that William Galley a Soldier in Col. Poseys detachment has not Received any pay since the first of Nov'r one thousand seven hundred & Eighty one. Given at Cumberland old Court House this 5th of Nov'r 1782 [other side]

Cumberland May 20th 1784

Pay the [undeciphered word] due on the within Certificate to the bearer hereof Mr. John B. Magruder which I am in great need of at this time being very Sickly & not able to work for my living & this Receipt shall stand good against.
