To His Excellency the Governor of the commonwealth of Virginia

The memorial of Alexander Galt of the City of Norfolk and State of Virginia, respectfully represents, that himself and relatives are the heirs at law of the late James Galt, who was heir at law of Dr Patrick Galt who was a surgeon in the army of Virginia and who died in service in the state of New Jersey. The said Dr Galt [several undeciphered words] when he entered the service – your memorialist is unable to state any thing about the services of Dr Galt except upon information which has descended in the family. He is informed that there is still [undeciphered word] and land bounty due to the heirs of Dr Galt. He respectfully asks a consideration of his claim & such allowance as may be right & proper [Borough of Norfolk, 19 April 1835]
