Virginia Bounty-Warrant Claim of Richard Coleman VAS370 Transcribed and annotated by C. Leon Harris

[From Revolutionary bounty-warrant files in the Library of Virginia.]

I do hereby certify that Capt. Richard Coleman late of the fifth Virginia Continental Regiment was a Lieutenant in the said Reg't. in the year one thousand seven hundred and seventy six, and served in that capacity 'till the nineteenth day of May one thousand seven hundred and eighty when he was entitled a Captaincy, and died the day following [sic] of the wounds he received in Colo. Bufords defeat [defeat of Abraham Buford, Battle of Waxhaws SC, 29 May 1780].
