I do certify that John Gesner Drum'r [drummer] enlisted in the 8<sup>th</sup> V'a Regiment in Feb or March 1776 for two years in Decem'r 1777 he reenlisted for three years at the expiration of which time he reenlisted for the War and continued in service till the Troops were Discharged at Winchester by proclamation of Congress – he served the greatest part of his time in my Company Novem'r 9<sup>th</sup> 178
