This day Came Thomas Gelford [several undeciphered words] Made oath that Naphthaliam Gregory was private for three years and that he died[?] in the service [several illegible words] before me one of the Justices of Bath County and State of virginia

Sworn to before me this 8th Day of november 1808 Robt Givens

I have known Thomas Gelford from his infancy & he is a man of respectability & entitled to full credit Robert Givens
