These may Certify that Sabret Grey enlisted in my Company [undeciphered] in the month of December one thousand seven hundred & seventy six and engaged for three years and Died in the Service before that [illegible] the said Grey has left a helpless Wife and [illegible] who is Extremely poor and much in [undeciphered] the pay due to Sabret Grey as aforesaid

Given under my hand this 6th September 1785 Thomas West

[other side] Fairfax County Ss

Leonard [undeciphered] of the said County made oath before me that his sister [undeciphered] Grey the widow of Sabred Grey, who enlisted as a Soldier in Capt. Thomas West's company & died in the service is still living, and that the said Sabred Grey left seven children, [three undeciphered words] the oldest of which, his son John Grey is now of age; [undeciphered] to the best of this Deponent's knowledge & Belief the said Sabred Grey died intestate.
