Dowden [Thomas Dowden W4181] of prince George County Virginia hereby Certify that I was well acquainted with William Wallace and that he enlisted for three years and Served the same in the fourteenth Regiment of Virginia Continetal army in the Revolutionary war Commanded By Col. Davis [sic: William Davies BLWt597-500] given under my hand this the 17<sup>th</sup> day of September 1831

I Thomas Harris [S38002] of prince george County Virginia do hereby Certify that I was well acquainted with William Wallace and that he engage in the Servis for three years in Captain Peter Jones [S8772] Company of the Fourteenth Regement of the Virginia Line Commanded by Col. Davis in the Revolutionary war and that he died in Servis. given under my hand this 20<sup>th</sup> day Sept. 1831
