Be it known that on the 6th day of October 1831 before Achilles Vawter One of the acting Justices of the peace in and for the County aforesaid John Grinsted of lawful age appeared and made oath that he was personally acquainted with James Grinsted and that he enlisted under Colonel William Mosby in the regular Servis and that he served three years and that James Grinsted William Grinsted & Lobilua[?] Grinsted who is since married who are the only heirs of the said James Grinsted and further this deponant saith not
