John Walker Enlisted in December Seventy Seventy seven [sic] In the Tenth Virg'a Reg't for the term of Three years and Died in the service. I served as a Capt. at that time given from under my hand this 15th of John Mountjoy [S36175]

P.S he died in the winter 1779 Entitled to depreciatio from the 11th [the rest missing]

Gentlemen Auditors please to settle with and Deliver to Capt. [undeciphered] what is due me by the Death of my husband John Walker a soldier in the 10th V. Reg't agreeable to the Certificate Likewise the Land Warrant and Oblige yours Humble Servt Mary hisXmark Walker Sept'r 12 1787

Stafford [undeciphered] The above order was given in my presence by Mary Walker the day and date above written
