By virtue of the orders of the Honorable Maj'r General [Nathanael] Greene Jno Walker the bearer [illegible] belonging to the third troops of the first Redgiment of Dragoons commanded by Colo George Baylor [W5966] has leave of absence from the s'd Redgiment till call for and then to return to such rendezvous as shall be appointed in the state of Virginia under pain of being considered and treated as a deserter the s'd summons being published in the Virginia news papers three weeks successively to be considered as sufficient notice Henry Bowyer [W5859]
