[The following are from rejected claims in the Library of Virginia.]

This day personally appeared before me J P Mosby a Justice of the peace in and for the County of Henrico, Agness Wade of said County and being first duly sworn according to Law deposeth and saith: That she recollects well the war of the Revolution, and thinks she was about Twenty years of age at the time peace took place. That she knew Benjamin Holmes who was a Soldier in the Revolutionary Army, that he enlisted in Henrico County under whom she does not remember, but that he was in the same company with a certain John Robinson. That it is not in her power to say in what years he served, but that he was in the Army between four and five years, for she well recollects his return and has frequently heard him speak of his services, and of his having his Discharge from the Army. And farther this affiant saith not.
