State of Ohio Pike county Ss

This day came Philip Wolfenbarger [W6575] personally before me John G. Lawrence (an Acting Justice of the Peace for the county and state aforesaid) being duly sworn deposeth and saith that he New Zachariah hoy was the lawful heir of John Hoy.

Question 2^{nd} did John Hoy the father of Zachariah Hoy enlist for three years or during the Revolutionary war Answer he enlisted for three years

Question 3rd do you know if the said John Hoy died in the service of the United States Answer. yes Question 4th what company did he enlist in Answer you may refer to Capt Clarks or Capt.[two undeciphered words].

And further this deponent saith not. sworn to and subscribed before me this 23rd day July AD one Eight hundred and twenty seven.
