I hereby Certify that Serj't. Jackson Enlisted in the 1<sup>st</sup> Regiment L Dragoons the 11th July 1781 and that the s'd Jackson served to the end of the War. [one illegible line]

By virtue of the order of the Honble Major General [Nathanael] Greene Serj't James Jackson belonging to the 5 Troop 1<sup>st</sup> rej't of Lt Dragoons Commanded by Col Geo Baylor [George Baylor W5966] has leave of absence from his said Regiment until called for then to repair to such rendezvous as shall be appointed in the State of Virginia under pain of being Considered and treated as a Deserter the summons to be published in the newspapers three weeks successively to be considered as sufficient notice. Given at Nelsons ferry [on Santee River in South Carolina] the 12 June 1783.
