It appears by the Books in this office that William Kernes a Soldier in the Virginia line on Continental establishment has received a Certificate on the 15^{th} may 1783 for £57.18.10 for the balance of his full pay – Given under my hand this 29 Sept'r 1807 A Lipscombe Clk
