I do certify that Joseph Kenny was Enlisted by me the 17th day of march 1777 to serve as a Soldier in the Regiment of Infantry Commanded by Colo. Wm Grayson [William Grayson BLWt1366-500] for the term of three years and continued in said Regiment till in the month of September 1778 when he went sick to a Hospital where I have reason to believe he died.

I do further Certify that there was three month pay due s'd Kenny when he went to the Hospital [illegible]

Given under my hand this 14th day of July 1783.
