I do hereby Certify that Smith Kent Serg't in Capt'n Mosleys Comp'y Col. Russels [William Russell BLWt1849-500] Regiment of infantry hath served the full time of his Inlisment and is hereby discharged from the s'd Regiment of The United States and that he hath not received any Satisfaction for The [undeciphered word] from the first day of December 1779 only two Dollars [undeciphered word] that was paid by the Commissary of Prisoners in Charlstown [sic: Charleston] S. Carolina and the above mentioned Serg't has been Enlisted in the in the Service ever since February one thousand seven hundred seventy seven. Given under my hand this 24th day of July 1780
