Richmond Decm'r 11th 1801

Sir: I have made an enquiry concerning your military Land I find it is not entered, and I cannot get a warrent unless you can get a Certificate from some respectfull officer in the Ridgement who will certify that you served your full time. if you will do that, and send it down while I am here I will get your warrent, and unless you do, I cannot get it, the Auditor was willing to certify that your pay was settled up; and he thought that might induce the Clerk of the [undeciphered word] to give a Warrent to the Register of the land office, but when I went back to him he would not unless you get a certificate from some officer of respectibility
