Febury 4<sup>th</sup> 1808

King & Queen County 2<sup>d</sup> Feby 1808

Thomas Lipscomb entered with Capt Holt Richeson [VAS1954] of the 7<sup>th</sup> Virginia Reg't as cadet, in the month of March 1776, soon after he was promoted to an Ensignsy & remained in line until the begining of the year One Thousand Seventy [sic] hundred & seventy nine, at which time s'd Lipscomb resigned his Commission. Given under my hand the date above.
