This day came Peter McClure before me one of the Commonwealth Justices and made oath that Daniel Cannihue is and heaer [sic: heir] to Dan'l[?] M Cannihen who was killed in battle at Fort laurence [sic: Fort Laurens OH, 23 Feb 1779] Aprele [?] 1806 [signed illegibly]

I Certify that Daniel M Cannehen was a Soldier under my Command in the thirteenth virginia regment and was killed in Battle at Fort Laurence April 2 1806 Tay of dely

no such name as David McCannan on the list of Cont. Soldiers in this Office [undeciphered] Office 21 May 1806 [signed illegibly]

Assign me wright and title of my land warrent unto David Scott senr witness my hand and seal.
