King William County to Wit state of Virginia

This day John Lipscomb [W5323] of said County came before me one of the Commonwealth Justices of the peace for the County aforesaid and made Oath that William Merrick dec'd who died the 29th day of January 1821 was a private Soldier in our old Revolutionary War (Seventy six) in the Continentel line, he Served a Tour duty Three years, as a faithful Soldier. He was a very poor man & died as such leaveing four or five small Children given under my hand this 25th day of March 1822.
