Nansemond County State of Virginia to Wit

This day came before me William Sumner a Justice of the peace for the County aforesaid Jeremiah Peale [W5521] of said County and State of Virginia and deposeth and sayeth that he was well acquainted with one William Metcalf of said County and State of Virginia that he knows that said William Metcalf was a Liutenant on the continental establishment in the War of the Revolution and that he well knows and recollects that he was in said service more than three years Given under my hand and seal as a Justice of the peace for the County of Nansemond this 1 day of May 1833

Besides being too vague to support the claim it does not appear even that Metcalf was in the Va Line nor is his name on the Army Register Rejected WR [Wyndham Robertson]
