I do Certify John Mills a Soldier in Lt Colo Hopkins [Samuel Hopkins BLWt1065-450] Detachment of the Virg'a line has served the full term of three years for which he wass Enlited and is hearby Discharged from the Service – that he has Rec'd his pay in Conteinentall Currencey from the first day of may seventy nine to the first day of Feb'y one thousand seven hundred and Eighty since which he has only Rec'd two Dollers in Speshe [sic: specie] from the Commisarey of Presoners in Charles Town [Charleston SC, surrendered 12 May 1780]
