I Rebecca Buffin aged seventy [undeciphered word] odd years do hereby certify that I was intimately acquainted with [blank space] Morgan before the revolutionary war and I know that said Morgan went early in the revolutionary war into service, that some one or two years after he returned home on a visit and staid a few days, and then returned to the army and never returned home again. I was info[rmed] that he [several illegible words]. Given under my hand this 13th day of December [illegible] [Certified in York County on 13 Dec 1833]

I George Thomas [S38440] do hereby certify that I was acquainted with John Morgan, that I became acquainted with him about the time of the Siege of York Town in Virginia That at the time of my getting acquainted with him he was in the army of the revolution, and as I understood was an adjutant. The said Morgan remained in service to the end of the war as I believe. I understood he died in service Given under my hand this 10th day of April 1834 [James City County]
