Virginia Montgomery county to wit.

This day Lidday Murphey personally appeared before me a Justice of the peace in and for said county and after being first duly sworn, saith that Butler Murphey who was a soldier in the Revolutionary war in the Virginia line departed this life on the 23<sup>d</sup> day of December 1827 she further states that the said Butler Murphey served three years and three months in the Virginia line in the company of Capt. [blank] in the regiment commanded by Colo. [blank] Lidday herXmark Murphy Sworn to and subscribed before me by the above named Lidday Murphy who is a person of truth and of good character, this Eigth day of April 1834 Wm Lewis JP
