This may Certify, that John Nunaley, enlisted in the 2nd Virg'a State Reg't as a Serjeant, for three years, prior to Jan'y 1777. That he exchanged with a Soldier of the 15th Virg'a Co. Reg't who was also for three years from Dec'r 76 on or about the 10th of Jan'y 1778. That he reinlisted for the war in s'd Reg't on the 19th day of Dec'r 1778 as a Serjeant. That he continued to serve as a Serj't, untill the first week in Jan'y 1782 when he was transferred, to Armongs Legionary Core [sic: Legionary Corps of Charles Armand BLWt2291-850] & that he is since Dead while in the Army.
