Know all me by these presents that I Drewry pattaford of greenville County and State of North Carolina for and in Consideration of three pound four shillings to me in hand paid by Samuel Parker of State and County Afforesaid do bargain Lease and make over all my Right and title of Land and pay due me for my service in the Cont'l Army and all the properties belonging thereto, said Pattaford doth Warrant and defend from him and his heirs the said Land and pay that is due to him from the publick, to the said Samuel Parker given Under my hand this 18^{th} of May 1784
