I do hearby Certify that Daniel Quiggs Soldier in C'o Russels [William Russell BLWt1849-500] Detacment from the Virginia Line has served the full terme of three years for which he Was Inlisted and is now hearby Discharg'd from the Servise, that he has Recved his pay in Continental money up to first day of Dec'r one thousand seven hundred & seventy Nine.

he has Rec'd two dollars in Specie from the Comissioner of Prisinors in Charlestown Given under my hand In WmBurg [Williamsburg] This 19<sup>th</sup> of July 1781
