I do Certify that Ephraim Ralph Entered into the Service of the United States in the in the 13<sup>th</sup> Virgi'a Reg't in the month of Dec 1776 as a Serg't and was appointed an Ensign in the said Reg't in the month of Octo'r 1778 and Continued in the said Reg't until the 7<sup>th</sup> of Feb'y 1780, when he Resign'd being then a Lieutenant Given under my hand at Fort Pitt april 11<sup>th</sup> 1785

We the Subscribers two of the Justices of the peace and of the Common pleas in & for the County of Westmoreland in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania do Certify to whome it may Concern that the Bearer Mr Thomas Ralph is the Reputed Father and Heir of the Estate of his son Ephraim Ralph which was in the Virgi'a [undeciphered] an Officer and is now Deceased and the Bearer is also Administrator of said Deceased's Estate Certified under our hands and Seals this Eleventh day of July one thousand seven hundred and Eighty five.
