It appearing to the court that Daniel Reagan has served three years as a noncommissioned officer in the first State Virginia Regiment. It is ordered that the same be certified. he being entitled to two hundred acres of land for the said service.

The Commiss'er refused to grant a warrant at First [undeciphered] said that the Court of Fairfax had no business with it. at Lenght I Prevaild on him to [illegible] grant in the soldiers name – my business ocationd me to Leave the citty before my turn took place and I could meet with no Second to Leave the Voucher with If you will send it down you may get a warrant in the soldiers name.
