I do Certify that I inlisted David Robertson as a Soldier for the War in September one thousand seven hundred & eighty & the said Robertson have been in the service as an eighteen Months man two months previous to his enlisting with me

Given this the 27 day of September 1783. Jo. Scott Jr. Capt [Joseph Scott W5993] 1<sup>st</sup> Virginia Regiment

A Coppy Cha. Jones C.A.
