James Robinson a private in Colo. Graysons [William Grayson BLWt1366-500] Reg't having servd the term of his Enlistment is hereby discharg'd the Service

a Certificate from Colo Grayson and some other Officer of the Regiment that James Robertson at the time of his enlistment was a Citizen of virg'a is necessary

Tho's Meriwether [Thomas Meriwether BLWt1920-400]

It appears by the books in this Office that a certificate issued on the 18th February 1784 in the name of James Robinson for Forty eight [illegible] 12½ for balance of his full pay as a soldier in the Virginia line on Continental establishment.
