Levin Hyslop [W7858] a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath that he was acquainted with Robert Rogers of this Co & that said Rogers enlisted in the 9th Va Regt for the term of three years & was captured at Germantown [4 Oct 1777] & imprisoned & was in service & imprisonment nearly or quite four years. Witness my hand & seal as a justice of the peace in & for Accomack Co this 21st day of January 1834.

Robert Russell sen'r. [W5753] a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath in due form of law that he was was well acquainted with Robert Rogers of this County – that said Robert Rogers enlisted in the 9th Va Regt for the term of three years & was captured with the witness at Germantown & imprisoned, & was in service & imprisonment nearly or quite four years with the witness.

Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for said County (Accomack) this 21st day of January 1834. Wm. R. Custis. JP
