I do hereby Certify that John Rosser Inlisted with me as a Matross in Colo Charles Harrison's [VAS1411] Reg't of Artillery the 11<sup>th</sup> of April 1777[?] for three years and that he was sent to the Hospital at Williamsburg as being unfit for Duty the [illegible] May 1777[?] at which time the Reg't was marched [illegible word] to Valley Forge Pennsylvania and never joined the Reg't after the above date he being Unfit for duty
