I certify that Robert Russell sen'r [W5753] a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath that Thos Salisbury of this Co inlisted in the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Reg't for three years & was captured & imprisoned at Germantown [4 Oct 1777] with the witness & that he was in service & imprisonment nearly or quite four years. Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for Accomack Co Jany 21<sup>st</sup> 1834 Wm R. Custis JP

Levin Hyslop [W7858] a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity made oath before me that Thomas Salisbury of this Co enlisted for three years in the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Reg't & was captured at the battle of Germantown & made a prisoner & was in service & imprisonment nearly or quite four years. Given under my hand & seal this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1834. Wm. R. Custis JP
