Robert Russell sen'r [W5753] a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity came before me & made oath that Richard Simpson of this Co enlisted for three years in the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Reg't & was captured & imprisoned at Germantown [4 Oct 1777] with the witness & was in service & imprisonment nearly or quite four years. Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for the Co of accomack this 21<sup>st</sup> Jany 1834.

Levin Hyslop [W7858] also a Revolutionary pensioner & a man of truth & veracity came before me & testified that Richard Simpson of this County enlisted for three years in the 9<sup>th</sup> Va Reg't & was captured at Germantown & was in service & imprisonment more than three yrs & nearly or quite four years. Given under my hand & seal as a Justice of the peace in & for accomack Co this 21<sup>st</sup> day of January 1834 Wm. R. Custis JP
