Samuel Sandefer late matross in Capt Pendleton [James Pendleton BLWt1749-300] Company of the first regiment of artillery Commanded by Colo Charles Harrison [VAS1411] haved served the term for which he stood engaged is hereby discharged the service of the United States his conduct as a Soldier justly intitelles him to the respect & esteem of all his countrymen given under my hand at the park of Artilery near Morris Town [Morristown NJ] this tenth day of Aprile 1780
