Ricjhm'd June 30 1786. I do Certify that Wm Satterwhite inlisted in Col. Marshalls [Thomas Marshall VAS494] Reg't of State Artillery about the 15 Sep'r 1777 for the term of three years which time he served as a Serjeant in the said Reg't and was Discharged, which it seems he has lost or misslaid.
