I do hereby certify that Thomas and Daniel Saunders reinlisted with me for the War in the Month of December 1778 and that they had serv'd before from the month of April 1776. Given under my hand this 16th day of October 1786. Robert Beale Capt [BLWt263-300] 3^d Virg'aa Reg't

Daniel Sanders serv'd in my Comp'y Untill the 16th June 1782 at which time he was wounded by the Indians in Georgia [probably at Ebenezer GA, 23 Jun 1782] & Died in two or three days after Thos. Sanders was taken prisoner in Chas Town [surrender of Charleston SC, 12 May 1780] & Died in captivity. A Parker Capt [Alexander Parker BLWt1740-300 & X874] 2nd Virg'a Reg't
