Westmoreland county State of Virginia To Wit

Be it known that Before me Robert Bailey A Justice of the peace in and for said county personally appeared Job Self aged 68 years and made Oath in due form of Law that he was Well acquainted with Zachariah Self and knew that the said zachariah self enlisted for and during the Revolutionary War and Well knows that the said Self Went into the army according to enlistment and never Returned nor was herd off afterwards by any of his friends or Relations and further that it is the prevailing opinion that he either died or was kill'd in the army In Testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand this 29 day of april 1831
