I farther certify that Mathew Shaw [undeciphered] Dragoons having been [undeciphered] in the state of Virginia is intituled by the Resolution of Congress, of the 13th February, 1779, to the Benefits that have been, or hereafter shall be, granted by the said State to the Noncommissioned Officers and Soldiers of the said Line.
